Dear Parents/ Carers,

This is an overview of what the children in the Nursery will be learning during the second half of the Autumn Term.

Being Imaginative

This term our role play will continue to be a cafe to promote speaking and listening and using their imagination.

Art and Design

The children will be painting firework pictures and poppies, they will be building models, making Diwali lamps and making celebration cards.





Literacy

The children will have a daily phonics session where they will be taught Phase 1 phonics using the 'Letters and Sounds' framework. They will be developing an awareness of sounds and developing an awareness of rhythm and rhyme in speech.



Physical Fine Motor Development

The children will be encouraged to draw simple pictures, use one-handed tools such as scissors and glue sticks and write their name.

Physical Gross Motor Development

The children will begin to take part in a P.E lesson every Monday. They will need to come to school dressed in their P.E. kit.
