Nursery Curriculum Overview Summer Term 2

Dear Parents/ Carers, This term's topic will be 'Under the Sea'

BEING IMAGINATIVE- This term our role play in the classroom will be a beach cafe. The children will also acting out stories such as 'The Rainbow Fish' and 'Shark in the Park'. We will be having a Pirate Day where your child can come to school dressed as a pirate (Friday 9th June)

ART- The children will have many opportunities throughout the term to explore a variety of materials such as painting, printing and model making. The children will be painting, drawing and colouring lots of under the sea pictures and will be encouraged to use colours for a purpose.













RE – This term we will be learning about special places. If you visit the Mosque, a wedding, a baptism or a special place please send in some photographs for us to share with the class

Hand Writing- Please practise writing your child's name with them, the numbers 012345 and the letters of the alphabet.

Sun Safety

Please remember to send your child to school wearing sun cream and a sun hat when the weather is hot. We also ask that you send your child to school with a water bottle full of water.

Climbing Equipment

Please do not let your child climb on any of the outdoor equipment at the beginning and the end of the school day.

PHONICS — Some of the children in the Nursery will continue to be taught Phase 1 Phonics. They will be focusing on alliteration and oral blending and segmenting of simple words. The other children will be learning the phase 2 letters and sounds.

Please encourage your child to sound out simple words such as cat, dog, hat and sun.



HOME LEARNING

We will be sending home a reading book for you to share with your child. This will be changed weekly. Please bring your child's book bag into school daily and ensure that you have made a comment about your child's reading in their reading record.

Please send your child to school every day with their school bag and reading book.

WORLD

The children will be reading lots of stories about sea creatures.







MATHEMATICS- 012345

We will continue to focus on number recognition and writing numbers from 0 to 10. We will be focussing on matching numbers to quantity, weighing objects, using positional language, 2d shapes and adding using the language 1 more. Please encourage your child to count objects, look for shapes in the environment and add two groups of objects together.
