BEING IMAGINATIVE- This term our role play in the classroom will be the Three Bears Cottage. The children will also acting out stories such as Goldilocks, The Gingerbread Man and The 3 Little Pigs.

ART- The children will have many opportunities throughout the term to explore a variety of materials such as painting, printing and model making. The children will be painting, drawing and colouring lots of Spring pictures and will be encouraged to use colours for a purpose.

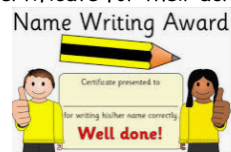


RE - We will be learning about Christianity and the Easter Story.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Every Monday the children in the Nursery participate in a P.E. lesson to improve their fine and gross motor skills. This will help to support your child with writing. Please can you practise writing your child's name with them at home. Children who can write their names will receive a certificate for their achievement.



Health & Self-Care

Please can you practise with your child putting their own coats on and fastening their zips and buttons. Can we also encourage you to support your child with putting on their own shoes too. This term we will be learning about keeping healthy and fit.

PHONICS - Some of the children in the Nursery will continue to be taught Phase 1 Phonics. They will be focusing on alliteration and oral blending and segmenting of simple words.

The other children will start Phase 2 learning lesson sounds.



HOME LEARNING

We will continue to send home a reading book for you to share with your child. This will be changed weekly. Please bring your child's book bag into school daily and ensure that you have made a comment about your child's reading in their reading record.

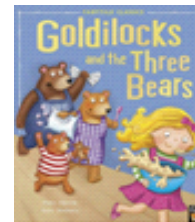
WORLD

The children will be learning about changes in the weather during the Spring season. The children will be planting Spring flowers and we will be going on a Spring walk. We will be growing cress and potatoes and will be having a special visit from the Animal lady and a local farm.



READING

The children will be reading lots of traditional tales.



We will be focusing on retelling stories, talking about characters and settings, ordering events that take place in a story and using story refrains such as 'Run, run as fast as you can'.

MATHEMATICS- 012345

We will continue to focus on number recognition and writing numbers from 0 to 5. We will be focussing on matching numbers to quantity, 2d shapes, patterns and adding using the language more, lots and the same. Please encourage your child to count objects, look for shapes in the environment and talk about the different patterns they can see in their homes. Please practise writing the numbers 1 to 10 at home with your child.
